### **OPENING (5-7 MIN)**

Briefly welcome everyone and say: For today's icebreaker, let's go in a circle and answer-

*Say:* If you notice, man-made things last a few hundred or thousand years. But in the grand scheme of things, that's a blip on the radar. Which changes the way we think about the things we do. Today we're going to look at what changes when we live today with forever in mind.

# **OPENING PRAYER (1 MIN)**

Say: But first, can someone start us off with a brief prayer for our time together?

# NUMBER OUR DAYS (7-10 MIN)

After the prayer, say: On Sunday, we heard a verse that helps set the tone for our discussion.

### CAN SOMEONE READ PSALM 90:12 ALOUD FOR US?

*After the reading, say:* As we learned on Sunday, there's numbering our days on earth, and then numbering our days in eternity. This leads us to asking all sorts of new questions.

# **HOW FOREVER CHANGES US (5-7 MIN)**

*After a discussion, say:* That's how forever changes the way you and I think, let's see how some Biblical writers began to think and live differently because they lived with forever in mind.
